Weather Policy & Cancellations

One Beach places the health and safety of our athletes as our highest priority. As an outdoor sport, we must consider the elements and their impact on our events and practice sessions. There are several conditions which may cause One Beach to cancel a scheduled event or session, including but not limited to:

- Severe Heat & Cold
- Rain
- Lighting Condition

When a parent, coach or other One Beach staff member raises a weather concern to a Head Coach and Director, One Beach leadership will begin internal discussions about potentially cancelling a session. After reviewing available weather information a cancellation decision will be made.

Communication

One Beach will primarily communicate a cancellation via email, using the provided emails we have on file. This email may come from info@onebeachaz.com or from the Head Coach of the affected facility/training group.

Our goal is to communicate a cancellation at least 2 hours before the event.

Players and parents are encouraged to share a cancellation notice with others to help ensure everyone is aware of a cancellation.

Rescheduling a Practice

Training schedules are determined through weeks of discussion, planning and feedback from many of our athletes. It is not an easy task to reschedule a practice to meet everyone's needs. Therefore, One Beach does not guarantee a cancelled practice will be scheduled. We encourage players to attend additional sessions at their primary or other training locations.

Refunds & Credits

One Beach will provide a refund or credit if cancellations exceed 3 or more per month for a specific location. Athletes should attend alternate training sessions to make up for 1-2 cancelled sessions.
